Hautlieu Sixth Form Registration

All applicants are required to confirm they are accepting their offer of a place on A Level or International Baccalaureate Diploma programmes between 11.30am and 2.00pm on Thursday 24th August 2017. **If you do not confirm acceptance of your place by this time we will assume that you do not wish to take up your place at Hautlieu.**

All applicants who have met the conditions of entry and simply wish to confirm acceptance of their offer of a place at Hautlieu can either:

- Telephone the school on 736242 during the above hours.
- E-mail the school – office@hautlieu.sch.je before 2.00pm on Thursday 24th August 2017.
- Attend the school in person between 11.30am and 2.00pm on Thursday 24th August 2017.

PLEASE NOTE: Applicants who would like to discuss their results and A Level or International Baccalaureate Diploma courses or course choices MUST attend the school between 11.30am and 1.00pm on Thursday 24th August or between 9.00am and 2.00pm on Friday 25th August.

If you wish to discuss your results or course choices on Friday 25th August, please ensure that you make contact with the school on Thursday 24th August, before 2.00pm, where an appointment with a member of the team will be made for you for Friday 25th. Course enrolment is on Monday 4th September, between 10.00am and 12.00 noon. Please note it is essential that you are on time for this day and are seated in the hall for a punctual start at 9.45am. If you do not attend this induction session we will assume that you will not be enrolling at Hautlieu for the 2017-18 academic year.

Highlands College Enrolment Days

All prospective students who have received a firm or conditional offer for their chosen course must attend one of the Enrolment Days on either Thursday 24th August, between 10.00am – 3.00pm and Tuesday 29th August between 10.00am – 1.00pm. Students are to arrive at main reception and will be guided into the Turner Building where they can enrol and pay for their course. Photo ID will also be taken as part of the enrolment process. Students must bring with them a copy of their offer letter, their examination results and any other supporting evidence to indicate that they have met the conditions of their offer.

If, for any reason, students are unable to attend one of the enrolment days, they should contact the Student Life Team on 608654 or email studentlife@highlands.ac.uk All offers of places are subject to a sufficient number of enrolments.

Other Post 16 Providers

Example: You have applied to both Highlands and Hautlieu and have gained the entry grades required for both. If you decide to go to Hautlieu, confirm that decision with Hautlieu and inform Highlands that you will not be taking up your place.
